In the past few months, many new and exciting things have been happening in here in Namitembo. We have received visitors from all over the world, shipments of donations have arrived and new projects are underway. In July the community received a container organised mainly by two of Ubwino Wa Amayi's greatest supporters, namely Joe Sweeney and Roger Byrne. Both of whom came out to Malawi in 2008 from Ireland to build the Montessori nursery school with their team. Since then they have been fundraising and with the help of friends and family, they have now supplied the people of Namitembo with items ranging from computers and fridges to basic first aid equipment and cooking utensils. Many books, toys and clothes have also been donated. Thanks to our friends overseas and many generous people and schools here in Malawi, we now have arguably the best equipped nursery school in the area! We have also started new projects with the girls who are supported by the charity. We are currently coordinating workshops after school, in an attempt to provide better pastoral care and develop the relationship between the girls themselves and organisation, so that they receive help and guidance on a personal level in addition to financial assistance with their school fees.
